

Tournament Teams

Terms of Reference

Within MWRA there are two tournament teams that exist in order to provide league members the opportunity for more competitive play appropriate to skill level. Each team is managed by a Team Rep. Team Reps are assigned based on seniority and team support. All team fees and jerseys are paid by individual team players and not funded through MWRA. Team winnings stay with the team, and its members decide how it will be spent or reinvested. Team rosters are reviewed on an annual basis to ensure all members meet the criteria appropriate for each tournament teams may be created based on registration numbers and interest.

MARKHAM PYLONS

The Markham Pylons are a "Rec" level tournament team established over 10 years ago. The team consists of a roster of players that have been part of the Pylons for a number of years. When a player is not available to play in a tournament due to injury or lack of availability, other players from within MWRA are invited to join the Pylons as a substitute player on a temporary basis. Should a position become vacant due to the departure of a player, the spot will be filled with a new player with the skill level appropriate for the team. The Pylons are managed by the Team Rep with input from team members in terms of adding players to the roster for tournaments.

MARKHAM COUGARS

The Markham Cougars are an Open "C/B" level tournament team established 4 years ago, with at least 5 previous years as the Open "C". The team consists of a full roster of players with the skills required for that level of play. When a player is not available to play in a tournament due to injury or lack of availability, other players from within MWRA are invited to join the Cougars as a substitute player on a temporary basis. Should a position become vacant due to the departure of a player, the spot will be filled with a new player with the skill level appropriate for the team. The Cougars are managed by the Team Rep with input from team members in terms of adding players to the roster for tournaments.
